



### **Weather Cancellation Policy**

Statement of Policy:	To set consistent procedures in the event of inclement weather (sub-zero weather, blizzards, rain storms, etc.)

Closing the church due to bad weather is a difficult decision under the best of circumstances. In case of inclement weather, we have two primary concerns 1) your safety, and 2) good communication.

If severe inclement weather or other emergency requires the cancellation of any of our scheduled activities or programs, we will implement the following procedures:

- Children and Youth programs- for the safety of our children and youth, we will follow the Monticello School Districts closure decisions during the week and post it on the WCCO closings website.
- Adult small groups or meetings will be determined by the group facilitator or leader. Please contact them for further information. Facilitators/leaders will need to secure a building key in order to meet with their group.
- Office closure and office staff reporting will be determined by the Lead Pastor and Council President. This information will also be posted on the WCCO closing website.
- All weekend and summer programs and Sunday morning service closures will be decided by the Pastor and the Council President and posted on the WCCO closing website.

In all instances, communication will occur at the earliest possible point. If available, we will try to post the information on Resurrection's website and via emails.

**Be Safe-** Your safety is important. Pay attention to local weather and travel conditions and use your judgment regarding safe travel to the church.
